• Living in Love and Commands

This is my commandment, that you love one another as I have loved you. John 15:12

Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your strength and with all your mind; and, Love your neighbor as yourself. **Luke 10:27**

Commands are an expression of God's love to us

Therefore you shall keep his statutes and his commandments, which I command you today, that it may go well with you and with your children after you, and that you may prolong your days in the land that the LORD your God is giving you for all time. **Deuteronomy 4:40** You did not choose me, but I chose you and appointed you that you should go and bear fruit and that your fruit should abide, so that whatever you ask the Father in my name, he may give it to you. **John 15:16**

Keeping the commands is a way to demonstrate Love

• Living in Love Creates Friendships

Greater love has no one than this, that someone lays down his life for his friends. You are my friends if you do what I command you. **John 15:13-14**
