SCRIPTURE READING - 1 John 3:11-24

II For this is the message that you have heard from the beginning, that we should love one another. I2 We should not be like Cain, who was of the evil one and murdered his brother. And why did he murder him? Because his own deeds were evil and his brother's righteous. I3 Do not be surprised, brothers, that the world hates you. I4 We know that we have passed out of death into life, because we love the brothers. Whoever does not love abides in death. I5 Everyone who hates his brother is a murderer, and you know that no murderer has eternal life abiding in him.

16 By this we know love, that he laid down his life for us, and we ought to lay down our lives for the brothers. 17 But if anyone has the world's goods and sees his brother in need, yet closes his heart against him, how

does God's love abide in him? 18 Little children, let us not love in word or talk but in deed and in truth.

19 By this we shall know that we are of the truth and reassure our heart before him; 20 for whenever our heart condemns us, God is greater than our heart, and he knows everything. 21 Beloved, if our heart does not condemn us, we have confidence before God; 22 and whatever we ask we receive from him, because we keep his commandments and do what pleases him. 23 And this is his commandment, that we believe in the name of his Son Jesus Christ and love one another, just as he has commanded us. 24 Whoever keeps his commandments abides in God, and God in him. And by this we know that he abides in us, by the Spirit whom he has given us.

SERMON - The Beginning of Love I John 3:11-24

• Love is Challenging

For this is the message that you have heard from the beginning, that we should love one another. I John 3:11

Love challenges those who give it.

Do not love the world or the things in the world. If anyone loves the world, the love of the Father is not in him. I John 2:15

Love challenges those who receive it and even observe it.

We should not be like Cain, who was of the evil one and murdered his brother. And why did he murder him? Because his own deeds were evil and his brother's righteous. I John 3:12

Do not be surprised, brothers, that the world hates you. I John 3:13

Beloved, do not believe every spirit, but test the spirits I John 4:I

Love is Life Giving

But if anyone has the world's goods and sees his brother in need, yet closes his heart against him, how does God's love abide in him? I John 3:17

For God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life. John 3:16

We know that we have passed out of death into life, because we love the brothers. Whoever does not love abides in death. I John 3:14

Little children, let us not love in word or talk but in deed and in truth. I John 3:18

• Love is greater than our Hearts

By this we shall know that we are of the truth and reassure our heart before him; for whenever our heart condemns us, God is greater than our heart, and he knows everything. I John 3:19-20

My little children, I am writing these things to you so that you may not sin. But if anyone does sin, we have an advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous. He is the propitiation for our sins, and not for ours only but also for the sins of the whole world. I John 2:I-2

And this is his commandment, that we believe in the name of his Son Jesus Christ and love one another, just as he has commanded us. I John 3:23

How great is the love the Father has lavished on us, that we should be called children of God! And that is what we are! I John 3:1
